Fellowship Program

1. Fellowship Description

Nanoori Hospital fellowship program is designed to provide fellows with intensive training in diagnosis and treatment of Minimally Invasive Spine Surgery & Techniques(MISST), and research to meet this growing demand. The fellows will learn to evaluate and treat routine and complicated all areas of the spine- cervical, thoracic, lumbar and lumbosacral as well as both surgical and non-surgical methods of treatment.

A rotated schedule permits the fellow to have equal experience with each group of spine surgeons and in the various area of learning. Fellows are accepted for the purpose of their education. Learning comes through a multitude of pathways.

- a. Reading textbooks and articles
- b. Observation in the operating room
- c. Participation in the clinic
- d. Participation in biweekly Nanoori Tele-Conference
- e. Participation in Daily Morning Conference of designated group
- f. Participation in research projects
- g. Writing papers and text books (Writing papers more than 1original article, 2 case reports)
- h. Writing daily report
- i. Assistance in case reports

A 'Nanoori Tele-Conference' is held weekly Friday with medical staff and nurses together. The each fellows will have opportunity to do a number of case presentations of your team's case. The director of the each team will select the journals, cases, and other topics every week to assign journal reviews or case presentations at this conference.

Fellows are expected to do the appropriate reading and be prepared to enter the discussion regarding assigned topics.
